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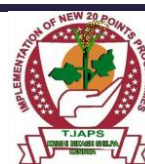

INTRODUCTION

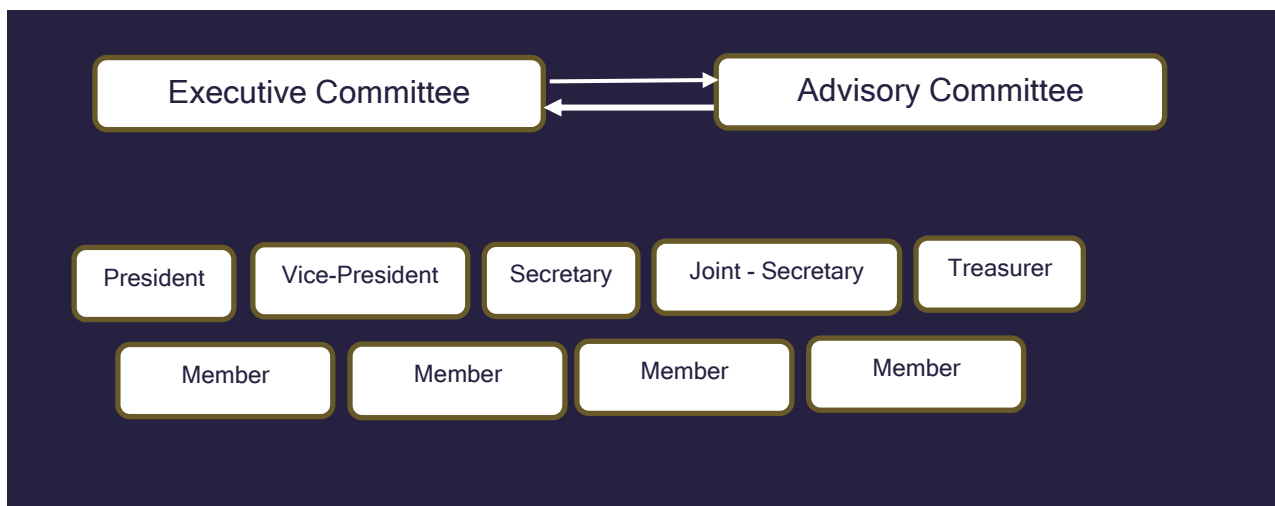
About Us

Activities

TJAPS Krishi Bikash Shilpa Kendra organizes youth training programmes to enhance skills and employment opportunities. Youth Development & Training Programme:

Since its establishment in 1983, TJAPS Krishi Bikash Shilpa Kendra has been deeply committed to empowering rural youth through skill development and training initiatives. Every year, the organization provides free training to nearly 200 students, helping them acquire practical skills for employment and self-reliance. The programmes cover areas such as tailoring, computer literacy, organic farming, and small-scale entrepreneurship. By nurturing talent and confidence, we enable youth to become active contributors to their families and communities. Our training sessions are conducted with experienced trainers who blend modern techniques with local needs. Many beneficiaries have successfully started their own income-generating ventures after completing the training. The initiative has reduced unemployment and migration by creating opportunities within rural areas. The programme especially emphasizes including girls and marginalized groups to ensure equal access to opportunities. Over the years, the training has transformed not just individuals but entire households. Through this long-standing effort, TJAPS Krishi Bikash Shilpa Kendra continues to shape a brighter and self-reliant future for rural youth.

Sapling Distribution Programme:

Medical Camp:

Experienced doctors and healthcare workers volunteer their services to reach people who have limited access to hospitals. Each camp benefits hundreds of villagers, especially those from SC, ST, and marginalized backgrounds. Along with treatment, the camps educate participants about healthy lifestyles and government health schemes. Through these initiatives, the organization continues to reduce health disparities and promote community well-being.

Robo Distribution Camp:

TJAPS Krishi Bikash Shilpa Kendra organizes robe distribution camps every year to support poor and needy families in rural areas. The initiative is aimed at providing comfort and dignity to underprivileged people, especially during festive seasons and winter months. Hundreds of robes are distributed among women, children, and elderly persons across different villages. This small but meaningful effort helps address basic clothing needs of marginalized groups. Through such welfare activities, the organization continues its mission of compassion and community service.

Educational material Distribution:

TJAPS Krishi Bikash Shilpa Kendra has been working tirelessly to promote education among underprivileged children through its Educational Material Distribution programme. Every year, the organization distributes school bags, books, notebooks, pens, and other study essentials to needy students. This initiative plays a vital role in reducing the financial burden on poor families who struggle to afford basic educational resources. Notable day Celebration:

These celebrations include cultural programmes, flag hoisting, awareness rallies, and community participation. School children, youth, women's groups, and local villagers take part in large numbers, making the events vibrant and meaningful. Such observances not only honor national pride and global causes but also strengthen social harmony and awareness. Through these activities, the organization inspires collective responsibility and a spirit of unity in the community.



FINANCIAL SUMMARY

Our Brief Financial report:

The financial year 2024–25 for TJAPS Krishi Bikash Shilpa Kendra reflects a balance between program implementation and financial discipline. The organization began the year with an opening balance of ₹47,308, comprising both cash in hand and bank deposits. Its primary source of income was training fees, which contributed ₹2,65,250, forming the backbone of revenue generation. On the expenditure side, the organization invested significantly in community services, including educational aid worth ₹25,250 and robe distribution amounting to ₹55,485. Medical camps were organized with an expenditure of ₹26,595, addressing critical health needs in rural areas. Administrative and operational expenses included rent of ₹36,000, conveyance of ₹18,965, telephone charges of ₹7,450, and general expenses of ₹18,985. To maintain financial compliance, audit fees of ₹1,000 and accounting charges of ₹4,000 were also incurred. Printing and stationery costs reached ₹6,455, while repair and miscellaneous expenses amounted to ₹3,265 and ₹4,185 respectively. Depreciation of assets was recorded at ₹42,553, ensuring transparency in asset valuation. At the close of the year, the organization maintained a healthy cash position with ₹41,250 in hand and ₹59,778 in the bank, totaling ₹1,01,028. Overall, the financial statements recorded a surplus of ₹11,167, highlighting efficient resource utilization. However, the auditor noted limitations such as incomplete documentation and lack of proper records for certain assets. Despite these challenges, the organization maintained its commitment to transparency and accountability. The year's financial performance demonstrates a careful balance between social impact activities and prudent financial management.
